## Med Pass Handout

- -Alcohol hands between patients, unless gross contamination, then soap and water
  - \* gross contamination includes dressings, topicals, patches, eye/ear/nose sprays or drops
- -Prepare only one resident's medications at a time: do not punch ahead.
- -Must wait at least 1 minute between inhalations, 2 minutes between nose drops or sprays in same nare, and 3 minutes between eye drops in same eye.
- -Administer only in private area, eye/nose drops or sprays, ear drops, patches, finger sticks, and inhaled Meds. Wear gloves to administer these Meds.
- -Observe patient to determine they swallow all medications.
- Resources on top of cart labeled/dated (water, pudding, juices)
- -Medcart must be locked when unattended.
- -Insulin dated when opened, replace after 28 days.
- -Advair and Serevent discus dated when opened, replace after 30 days.
- -Travatan and Xalatan eye drops dated when opened, replace after 42 days.
- -Glucose strips dated when opened, expiration date on side of container \*discard after 28 days
- -Clean glucometer before and after each use with manufacturer approved cleaner.
- -Initial and date all patches when applied. Glove up. Hand hygiene soap and water
- -Destroy Fentanyl Patch; glove up to handle, fold in half, have another nurse observe destruction by placing in sharps container, and both sign Narcotic Book.
- -Pump Nasal sprays must remain upright at all times, ie Flonase.
- -Narcotic book must be signed when control drug is taken out of lock box, before it is given.
- -Initial MAR after administration of Meds., except control drugs.
- -MAR must be closed when away from Medcart.
- -Compare MAR to Rx on all medications for correctness. ie, Does strength match?
- -No personal food or drink on Medcart. Keep hand sanitizers in pocket not on top of cart
- -Do not leave any medications on top of Medcart when away from cart or at bedside.
- -Place liquid measurement on top of cart (level area, at eye level) to determine correct amount.
- -Shake Dilantin suspension at least 15 seconds before preparing dose.
- -Use syringe to measure out Dilantin, Depakote, Iron Liq., or Potassium.
- -Dilute Iron liquid or Potassium liquid with at least 120 mls of liquid before giving to patient, including G-Tube patient.
- -Dilantin Suspension; dilute dose with 20mls of water before giving through tubing, then flush with at least 20 mls of diluent. Continuous enteral feedings should be stopped 1-2 hours before and after each dose.
- -Give with a full glass of water, Potassium, Fibercon.
- -Do not place empty Medcards. in trash unless patient name, and Rx number is marked out or tear top of card off and dispose in shredder.
- -Make sure you know how to read Insulin Syringes.
- -Scrubs dragging the ground is a contamination issue.
- Do not give Cymbalta with chocolate (pudding/mik)
- -Liquid KCl and Iron: mix with 120 ml/H20, give with food
